- Q. Where do I go for my doctor's appointment?
 - A. You will go to the same location and see the same doctor. This change will not impact your medical care.

 - A. Anyone needing immediate support can contact ACCKWA or Guelph CHC.

We expect no interruptions to services.

ACCKWA will work in a temporary space at a Guelph CHC location until they find a permanent space in Guelph.
